RACING RECAP

Joe Linam in #63 copted his second consecutive heat, as he received the checkered flag in the first Junior Modified heat. #5 Nathan Robinson was right behind Linam for second and #312 Frank Cooper was third. #60 Rosebeary took the lead on the second lap, and went on to win the second heat, followed by #58 Shelby second and #78 Bradley third. #33 Clouse was the big winner in the consolation, with #312 Cooper second and #80 Cooksey third. Rosebery in #60 led the trophy dash for all six laps to take home the trophy. #78 Bradley was right on Rosebeary's bumper for second and #63 Linam third. #60 Rosebeary added another one to make five consecutive feature win this year, as he received the flag in the Junior Modified feature. #78 Bradley came under second, #63 Linam third and #33 Clouse fourth.

Chuck Bradley in #44 won the first Hobby Stock heat, followed by #20 Holland second and #23 Ray third. Clark in #63 moved out from his outside position on the first lap to win the second heat. #80 Williams in the "Lido Special" was second and #59 Smith third. #91 White was the victor in the consolation after holding off #68 Maness for five laps, Maness was a close second and #99 Weaver third. 




CHECKERED

Completion of event, regardless of number of laps completed.




GREEN

One lap to go.




